PURPOSE

Whereas these events allow the sale of liquor in the building, special consideration and regulations must be followed.

POLICY

- 1. Any group or organization wishing to hold a beer garden in the Stadium must contact the Stadium Foreman and tentatively book the facility.
- 2. Once the facility has been tentatively booked, the rentee must obtain security services from a recognized security company which are, in the opinion of the Stadium Foreman, satisfactory for the event. This may include police security if necessary.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the group/organization to obtain the necessary liquor license required by the N. S. Liquor License Board. This must be shown to the Stadium Foreman 48 hours prior to the event. The provisions of the license and the liquor control act must be strictly adhered to.
- 4. Sale of all liquor tickets will cease at midnight and the bar will close at 12:30 AM. The band may play until 1:00 AM. Everyone is to be vacated from the building by 2:00 AM.
- 5. The Stadium will supply N. S. Amusement Admittance tickets.
- 6. No one is allowed to take liquor off the main floor area.
- 7. A standard contract outlining other agreements relating to rental costs, clean up charges, cooler renter, stage, insurance, etc., is also to be signed by the group or organization prior to the facility being used. A deposit of fifty percent (50%) of contract amount is required upon signing. If this event is cancelled, other than bay an "Act of God", this deposit shall be forfeited.

Failure to comply with the above regulations will result in the Leisure Services Advisory Committee canceling further beer garden events for the group or organization.
